- The fence approved at a prior meeting is up and working great. Preschool parents are still allowed inside the fence. There hasn't been many complaints or questions. There are still some parking issues.
- Kim Cole updated us on the Colorful Run. They were able to get sponsorship letters out. There is close to \$2,000 in sponsorship money. The run will start on the track.
