Approval of Minutes

Treasurer's Report

Cheryl Hochendoner presented the Treasurer's Report. There was a lot of activity in September. Member dues were taken in as well as Fall Festival donations. There were some minimal expenses to report: the photo booth was paid for as well as the PTA officer's shirts. Current balance \$14,264.45

Fall Festival Committee Report

Jen Darney presented. Fall Festival is October 24, 2015. We received \$650.00 in donations. She also explained how the classroom baskets raffle worked: each classroom receives the money back from the raffle. She also stated that more volunteers are needed. There are no pumpkins this year, but a photo booth will be put in the gym instead with unlimited pictures.

New Business

- Halloween Party- Brandy Hinkle stated that classrooms are short on help with some classes having only 2 parents volunteering. She also reminded helpers of the new Raptor System and that a State ID is required to enter the building.
- Sheila Factor spoke about the pie fundraiser. Orders are due October 30th which gives Gardner Pies 10 days to fill the order. They are to be picked up on Friday, Nov. 13th. Only 1 order form for each family is needed. Each family that sells 5 pies will receive a pizza party, and those that sell 12 will get to pie the principal or a volunteer teacher. The child and teacher who sells the most pies will receive a \$100 gift card, second-most will receive a \$75 gift card, and third-most will receive a \$50 gift card.
- Santa's workshop will be at the beginning of December. Volunteers are needed to help children with their purchases. We will also give each child \$1 coupon for purchasing presents. Jessica Yonkey brought up that we had discussed parents volunteering to wrap presents at a previous meeting. It was decided that we will purchase the wrapping materials and ask for additional parent volunteers help wrap the presents. Brandy Hinkle brought up the idea of the High School students coming over to help wrap during Study Hall. Sheila stated that she would ask Ms. Fisk and Ms. Yantes to see if that is possible.
- Jen Darney brought up a new fundraiser idea in selling mums from Chuck's Greenhouse. They are 8" mums that will be sold for \$6.00. We will receive \$3.00 of each flower sold. She said we would have to begin fundraising 2 weeks after the first day of school. Chuck's Greenhouse also sells Poinsettia's for \$12, but no Easter lilies or tulips. Can be something to think about for next year.
